

Accessing COVID-19 Antiviral Treatment in Ottawa

Antiviral treatments are available for higher-risk adults with COVID-19. Available treatments (like Paxlovid) can prevent serious illness if taken within 5 days of the start of symptoms. A doctor can tell you if you are at higher risk and may be eligible.



You may be at higher risk if you are:

- Immunocompromised (have an immune system that is weakened by a health condition or medications)
- 70 years of age and older
- 60 years of age and older with less than three vaccine doses
- 18 years of age or older with less than three vaccine doses and at least one risk condition
